3. Booth will be set up on sidewalks and in the street.
4. Exhibitors are responsible for their own tables and displays.
5. Booth assignments will be made by March 15, 2008.
6. Port Gibson Main Street and Heritage Festival will not be responsible for any loss or damage to work or injury to any participating person. There will be walking Security during the day.
7. There will be no knives, guns, whips or weapons of any type, silly string, stink bombs, hair color spray or any item deemed by the Co-chairman of Arts and Crafts to be unsuitable for sale at the Heritage Festival.
8. The Festival reserves the right to remove work declared unsuitable for a family oriented show. If a Co-chairman of Arts and Crafts requests that you remove an item for sale and you do not, you will be asked to leave.
9. Exhibitors are responsible for collecting sales tax at the rate of 7%. Envelopes and calculation sheets will be provided. Before you leave for the day, tax envelopes must be placed in the night depository of RiverHills Bank.
10. All exhibitors are required to stay until the show closes.
11. You are responsible for cleaning trash from your booth area.
