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FOOD VENDOR CONTRACT

The following contractual agreement is made between:

_____ Vendor, and Port Gibson Main Street
Heritage Festival. Responsibilities of both parties are as follows.

1. Fee of \$_____ to be paid by vendor no later than March 15th, 2008 to Port Gibson Main Street Heritage Festival. This year's Festival will be on March 29th, 2008.
2. Port Gibson Main Street Heritage Festival reserves the sole right to select qualified vendors to participate in the Festival. Selection will be based on factors to minimize duplication of product and maximize quality. There will be no exclusives. See enclosed attachments.
3. Hours of operation are 8:00 am until dusk. Because of traffic congestion no vendor will be permitted to leave his assigned location until sales tax has been received and until authorized to do so by event chairperson.
4. Coffee and hot tea may be sold by vendors. **Vendors cannot sell soft drinks or shaved ice products.** The Port Gibson Heritage Festival has an agreement providing exclusive rights for Pepsi products, including lemonade, iced tea, and bottled water. Ice must be purchased through the Heritage Festival if needed.
5. Vendors must follow State health permit guidelines as provided.
6. Vendors will be notified of their selection to participate upon receipt of application.
7. The following policies are now in effect.
 - a. Non-discrimination - The Port Gibson Heritage Festival is sponsored by Port Gibson Main Street, Inc, a 501 (c) 3 corporation whose policy is not to discriminate on the basis of race, color, creed, national origin, sex, sexual orientation, or disability. During the Festival it is expected that all vendors and their representatives will adhere to a similar policy and anyone deemed not to be adhering to such policy will be asked to leave the Festival.

b. No Alcohol Sales – No vendor will be allowed to sell or distribute alcoholic beverages of any time during the Festival.

c. Pepsi Drink Products Only – As part of our sponsorship agreement with Pepsi Cola/Brown Bottling Group, only Pepsi drink products may be sold at the Festival and all such products must be purchased through the Festival.
